



Juan Manuel Irache obtained his Ph.D. degree in Pharmacy (Specialist in "Industrial Pharmacy and Galénica" and "Analysis of Drugs and Medicines") from Navarra University in 1990. He has been post-doctoral fellow of the "Centre of Pharmaceutical Studies" at the Paris Sud University, France. In 1993, he received a position in the Maître de Conférences Universitaire at the Rouen University (France) where he teaches in the Faculty of Pharmacy until 1996. In 1996, he joined as Professor of Pharmaceutical Technology at the University of Navarra.

Currently, his research focuses on: New Pharmaceutical Dosage Forms (Microparticles and Nanoparticles); Oral Drug Delivery Systems as bioadhesive carriers for specific delivery of macromolecules; and New adjuvants based on the polymeric particles for vaccination and immunotherapy purposes. He is co-author of more than 200 peer reviewed articles, over 30 book chapters and 16 issued inventions covered by patents.
